From the North: Take U.S. Highway 101 South into Newport. Continue traveling south through Newport until you reach the stoplight at Hurbert Street, which is about three blocks south of the major intersection of U.S. Highways 20 and 101. Hurbert Street intersects Highway 101 at the top of a hill (you'll see Mazatlan Mexican Restaurant to your right); turn right onto Hurbert and continue forward through the 4-way stop. Halfway down the next block, turn right at the McCarthy Building into the professional plaza with a horseshoe-shaped parking lot. Our building is at the back of the "horseshoe," a grey-blue building with tan trim.

From the South: Take U.S. Highway 101 North into Newport. Continue traveling north through Newport, over the Yaquina Bay Bridge, until you reach the stoplight at Hurbert Street (you'll see Mazatlan Mexican Restaurant to your left). Turn left onto Hurbert Street and continue forward through the 4-way stop. Halfway down the next block, turn right at the McCarthy Building into the professional plaza with a horseshoe-shaped parking lot. Our building is at the back of the "horseshoe," a grey-blue building with tan trim.

From the East: Take U.S. Highway 20 West into Newport. Turn left (south) at the major intersection of U.S. Highways 20 and 101. Continue traveling south on Highway 101 for about three blocks until you reach the stoplight at Hurbert Street, which intersects Highway 101 at the top of a hill (you'll see Mazatlan Mexican Restaurant to your right); turn right onto Hurbert and continue forward through the 4-way stop. Halfway down the next block, turn right at the McCarthy Building into the professional plaza with a horseshoe-shaped parking lot. Our building is at the back of the "horseshoe," a grey-blue building with tan trim.

As Highway 20 enters Newport from the west and intersects Highway 101, it turns into Olive Street. Turn left (west) onto Olive Street and continue forward for one block to the 4-way stop. Turn left onto Nye Street; our office is painted brown and located on the right (west) side of the street about in the middle of the block at the end of a string of professional offices (just south of the Department of Human Services building). From the East: Take U.S. Highway 20 West into Newport. As Highway 20 enters Newport and intersects Highway 101, it turns into Olive Street. Continue west through the intersection of Highways 101 and 20 onto Olive Street, and continue forward for one block to the 4-way stop. Turn left onto Nye Street; our office is painted brown and located on the right (west) side of the street about in the middle of the block at the end of a string of professional offices (just south of the Department of Human Services building). If you get to the Post Office, you've gone too far; our office borders the Post Office parking lot.
